Position Title: Research Assistant on “Muslims for American Progress” (MAP) project

Summary Description:

ISPU is seeking an entrepreneurial research professional with experience in community based field research to join a project aimed at quantifying American Muslim contributions to the city of New York (including all 5 boroughs) in eight key areas (medicine, STEM, civic engagement and democracy, philanthropy, economic development and job creation, arts and entertainment, sports, and education). Ideal candidate has experience working within and/or researching the NYC Muslim community; identifying their contributions or activities; and has the ability to engage academics, American Muslim leaders and media professionals alike. Project would require a 12 month commitment.

Scope of activities:

- Work with the PI to refine research strategy and scope of meaningful measure of contribution for each of the eight key areas identified
- Work with the PI to set up a system to gather, count and profile contribution in eight key areas identified
- Conduct mixed mode data collection - including qualitative one one one interviews and qualitative review of secondary resources
- Contribute to analyzing the data
- Contribute to communications plan for gathered information
- Be available for weekly check in with project manager at date and time agreed upon after kick off meeting

- Experience conducting qualitative interviews
- Ability to engage academics and American Muslim leaders
- Demonstrated ability to gather, analyze, and present information in a clear, concise, and understandable manner
- Strong interpersonal, cross-cultural, and problem-solving skills
- Highly motivated individual with the ability to work independently and operate on a flexible work schedule
